The Project proposes improvements to the Rialto Channel, which extends approximately 2.97 miles between Willow Avenue and Etiwanda Avenue in the City of Rialto. The Proposed Project will involve grading activities such as excavation and fill, construction of a reinforced concrete rectangular and trapezoidal channel, and the replacement of undersized reinforced concrete box (RCB) culverts at multiple street crossings. The improvements are designed to convey flows associated with a 100-year flood.
