### **Re: Central Transport Logistics Truck Terminal Project – Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND)**

Dear Steve Kowalski:

Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the environmental review process for the Central Transport Logistics Truck Terminal Project. The Local Development Review (LDR) Program reviews land use projects and plans to ensure consistency with our mission and state planning priorities. The following comments are based on our review of the January 2026 MND.

Please note this correspondence does not indicate an official position or approval by Caltrans on this project and is for informational purposes only.

#### **Project Understanding**

The proposed project would demolish an existing 14,640-square-foot truck terminal facility and construct an approximately 45,400 square-foot truck terminal facility containing approximately 40,300 square feet of transfer facility uses and 5,100 square feet of ancillary office space on the site. New paved parking areas would be installed along the southern, southeastern, and northwestern portions of the site as well as around the perimeter of the proposed building.

#### **Construction-Related Impacts**

Project work that requires movement of oversized or excessive load vehicles on State roadways requires a transportation permit that is issued by Caltrans. To apply, please visit Caltrans Transportation Permits ([link](#)).

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Prior to construction, coordination may be required with Caltrans to develop a Transportation Management Plan (TMP) to reduce construction traffic impacts to the State Transportation Network (STN).
