Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Project includes the widening of the Western Way right-of-way (ROW) from Van Buren Boulevard to Harley Knox Boulevard (approximately 0.5-mile) with four 12-foot wide through lanes, including left turning lanes at the intersection of Nandina Avenue and Western Way. The Project would install new sidewalks and a retaining wall as well as relocate traffic signals, streetlights, crosswalks, ADA compliant ramps, sidewalks, and curb and gutter within the ROW. Some utilities within the ROW would also be relocated as part of the widening. Financing for the design and ROW acquisition would come from local funds.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The Proposed Project has the potential for impacts related to: 1) Biological Resources, 2) Cultural Resources, 3) Geology and Soils, and 4) Tribal Cultural Resources. These potential impacts would be reduced to a less than significant threshold with the implementation of mitigation measures discussed in the IS/MND, including Mitigation Measures BIO-1 through BIO-6, CUL-1, CUL-2, GEO-1, TCR-1, and TCR-2.
