WM is pleased to support the business community in Riverside County by providing reliable and compliant solid waste collection services.

The new commercial development at 41699 Camino Del Vino, which we understand will include a restaurant and wine tasting space, will require both trash and recycling services. To ensure compliance with California's State Recycling Mandates (AB 341, AB 1826, and SB 1383), the waste enclosure should be designed to accommodate:

- A minimum of two 6-yard bins (one for trash and one for recycling)
- A minimum of four 64-gallon carts for organic waste

Once the business is operational, a WM Business Recycling Representative will be available to assist in evaluating the appropriate level of recycling and organic waste service to meet regulatory requirements.
