Project Title: Timber Harvest Plan “Hoover Ridge THP” 1-25-00068-SON (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SON-60492-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at unnamed tributaries to, and including, Buckeye Creek in the County of Sonoma, State of California; Sections 31, 32, and 33, Township 11N, Range 13W; Sections 4 and 5, Township 10N, Range 13W; U.S. Geological Survey maps Annapolis and Gube Mountain; Mt. Diablol Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SON-60492-R3 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Alexandra Gioseffi, representing Sustainable Conservation, Inc.

The Project is limited to installation of rocked fords, culverts, and temporary fill crossings within Class II and III watercourses; removal of aggregated material and culvert replacement within Class II and III watercourses; and water drafting within a Class I watercourse, as denoted in the approved 1-25-00068-SON “Hoover Ridge THP”.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 1/28/2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Timber Harvest Plan prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
