Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed trail would total approximately 1.75 miles of an off-street paved Class I shared-use path. The proposed trail would include two components: 1) a two-foot wide paved shoulder nearest to the channel and an eight-foot wide paved trail for pedestrians and cyclists and 2) a five-foot wide decomposed granite trail for equestrian use and a two-foot wide earthen swale located on the western side of the path. Proposed intersection improvements at Coronado and Main Street would include at-grade crossings.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

**Biological Resources:**  
Mitigation measure BIO-1 would be implemented to avoid and/or minimize any potential impacts on nesting birds.

**Cultural Resources:**  
With implementation of Measure CUL-1, potential impacts on unknown archaeological resources that may underlie the project site would be reduced. Measure CUL-2 would be implemented in the event that historic or precontact archaeological resources are unearthed. Measure CUL-3 would ensure a qualified archaeologist prepares a final report is prepared at the conclusion of archaeological monitoring. CUL-4 will be implemented if human remains are encountered unexpectedly during implementation of the Project.

**Geology:**  
Measure GEO-1 would be incorporated for potential impacts on paleontological resources.

**Tribal Cultural Resources:**  
Measures TCR-1, TCR-2, and TCR-3 would be implemented to minimize potential impacts to tribal cultural resources.
