



**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION
FOR THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA**

PLANNING CASE PR:2021-000894 (GPA, RZ, CUP, DR, PCRN, VR): Proposal by Steve Berzansky of Steven Walker Communities to consider the following entitlements for the construction of a vehicle fueling station with a 4,650 square foot convenience store on 1.3 acres: 1) General Plan Amendment to amend a portion (0.62 acres) of the project sites land use designation from O - Office to MU-V – Mixed Use – Village; 2) Zoning Code Amendment to Rezone 0.62 acres from R-1-7000 – Single Family Residential Zone to CR – Commercial Retail Zone and 0.7 acres from MU-V – Mixed Use – Village Zone to CR – Commercial Retail Zone; 3) Conditional Use Permit to permit a vehicle fueling station and off sale of alcohol (Type 20 Beer and Wine); 4) Design Review of project plans; 5) Public Convenience or Necessity to allow for an over concentration of off-sale alcohol licenses in Census Tract 315.04; and 5) A Variance to allow a reduced separation from a business licensed for the off-sale general of alcoholic beverages. The Planning Division of the Community & Economic Development Department recommends that the Planning Commission determine the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP).

NOTES: *It should be noted that Tribal Consultations have been conducted pursuant to S.B. 18 and A.B. 52.*

PROJECT LOCATION: The vacant 1.3-acre project site is on three contiguous parcels, located at 6902, 6892, and 6836 Arlington Avenue, situated on the southeast corner of Arlington Avenue and Monroe Street, in the R-1-7000 – Single Family Residential Zone and MU-V – Mixed Use - Village Zone, in Ward 3.

HAZARDOUS WASTE SITES: Pursuant to Section 15087.c.6 of the Guidelines for California Environmental Quality Act the City acknowledges the non-existence of hazardous waste sites within the project area reviewed by this Mitigated Negative Declaration.
