Title: Issuance of a Non-Exclusive Geological Survey Permit

Location: Sovereign land in the San Joaquin River, North of the Mossdale Railroad Bridge, in Lathrop, San Joaquin County

Description: Authorize issuance of a Non-Exclusive Geological Survey Permit beginning February 9, 2026, for a term of 1 year, for the collection of geological data by mud-rotary drilling method.

Name of Approving Public Agency: California State Lands Commission

Name of Proponent (Person or Agency): City of Lathrop

Exempt Status: Categorical Exemption

- CLASS 6, INFORMATION COLLECTION (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15306)

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a 1-year Non-Exclusive Geological Survey Permit for the above-mentioned activity will cause only a minor physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemption applies.
