Project Description

Project Title: Amendment No. 2 to Revenue License Agreement No. 10-752 with City of Loma Linda

Project Location: The Project is located within a portion of San Timoteo Creek, south of Redlands Boulevard and west of Anderson Street (Assessor's Parcel Number: 0283-062-30).

Project Description: The San Bernardino County Flood Control District is proposing Amendment No. 2 to Revenue License Agreement No. 10-752 with City of Loma Linda for non-exclusive access to approximately 3,450 square feet of land running parallel to the Flood Control District right-of-way at San Timoteo Creek. The license allows for the operation and maintenance of one (1) 2-inch PVC electrical conduit and one 1/4-inch conduit. The amendment would extend the existing license term for an additional five (5) years, from February 16, 2026, through February 15, 2031.
