Project Description

Project Title: Amendment No. 2 to Revenue License Agreement No. 06-800 with Cucamonga Valley Water District
Project Location: The Project is located along the west side of Day Creek Channel, from Sixth Street southerly to Fourth Street, in the City of Rancho Cucamonga, within portions of APN 0229-271-17.
Project Description: The San Bernardino County Flood Control District is proposing Amendment No. 2 to Revenue License Agreement No. 06-800 with Cucamonga Valley Water District, for the continued non-exclusive access along the west side of District Facility Day Creek Channel wall, between Sixth Street to Wineville Avenue, in City of Rancho Cucamonga. The license allows for the installation, operation and maintenance of an 8" underground potable waterline running approximately 3,865 lineal feet parallel to Flood Control District rights-of-way. The amendment would extend the existing license term for an additional five (5) years, from March 1, 2026, through February 28, 2031.

Additionally, because this action is purely administrative and transactional in nature, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity may have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore it also qualifies for a commonsense exemption under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
