NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION
City of Tulelake Wastewater Improvement Project

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that City of Tulelake intends to adopt a Negative Declaration (ND) for the City of Tulelake Wastewater Improvement Project. The ND has been approved for public review by the City of Tulelake Chief Resilience Officer. Copies are available for review and comment at the City of Tulelake City Hall, 591 Main Street, Tulelake, California 96134. Comments and recommendations on the adequacy of the environmental document may be filed at the aforementioned address during the public review period established for the project.

1. **PROJECT:** City of Tulelake Wastewater Improvement Project
2. **APPLICANT/AGENT:** City of Tulelake

3. **LOCATION:** The proposed project components are located at various locations throughout the incorporated areas of Tulelake, California, Siskiyou County. Total area of impact is approximately 7.3 acres. Some of these sites are located on public city property. Sewer lines are proposed on Sixth Alley from Modoc Avenue to F Street, Fifth Alley from Modoc Avenue to F Street, Fourth Alley from C Street to F Street, and the alley of Park St from G Street to Ridgeview St. Manholes are proposed at sixteen locations on public city property including the intersection of Modoc Avenue and Sixth Alley, intersection of E Street and Sixth Alley, intersection of F Street and Sixth Alley, intersection of Modoc Avenue and C Street, intersection of D Street and Fifth Alley, intersection of E Street and Fifth Alley, intersection of F Street and Fifth Alley, intersection of Siskiyou Street and C Street, intersection of Park Street and G Street, intersection of Park Street alley and G Street and to the east of Ridgeview Street. Two proposed lift stations are located at the intersection of Siskiyou Street and C Street and Park Street and G Street. A headworks screening facility is located on one parcel (APN 050-051-010) adjacent to the Tulelake Wastewater Treatment Plant located east of Dean Callas Way. The project area is owned by the City of Tulelake and is in Township 48 North, Range 04 East, Section 35 of the Mount Diablo Meridian.
4. **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The City of Tulelake proposes improvements to the wastewater system. This proposed project includes the planning and design to install approximately 4,900 feet of 8" PVC sewer collection piping, replace C Street sewer lift station, replace Park Street sewer lift station, install headworks screening facility, and install screening equipment at lift station. These plans will improve the City of Tulelake wastewater collection system.

The ND has a review period of **30 days**, starting on **November 25, 2025**, and ending on **December 26, 2025**, which has been approved by the State of California, Land Use and Climate Innovation. Please take notice that - pursuant to Public Resource Code Section 21177, Government Code Section 65009, and other applicable law - if you challenge the proposed action described above in court, then you may be limited to raising only those issues or objections you or someone else raised during the public comment period, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Tulelake within the review period.

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
