

R: This project will place a new road surface on an existing deteriorated section of roadway. The project involves placing a slurry seal coat over the streets within the existing

curb width. Other improvements include crack seal, mill/fill resurfacing, and subgrade and asphalt base repairs to prepare the existing surface to be coated.

10.Q: What problem is the project intended to solve?

R: Project will extend the lifetime of the roadway to postpone deterioration and costly repairs such as potholes and requiring a complete new surface to repair.

11.Q: Why is the project being proposed now?

R: The roadway base is still in good condition and completing the project at this time allows the roadway design to be a slurry of the surface only and not a full reconstruction. Leaving the road to deteriorate further will result in additional cost to the City to replace the roadway in the future.

R: The project involves placing a slurry seal over the existing road surface. It is a maintenance project that will not change the existing use, width, or structural section of roadway.

R: No new structures will be constructed.

R: The project limits include sections of Thompson Blvd, Sanjon Rd, Main St, Telephone Rd, Telegraph Rd, and Kimball Rd. All work will be done within the City's Right-of-way. Refer to attached project exhibits (DWG. 2025 – D – 005).

R: The project involves placing a slurry (about 183,600 square yards) on the streets within the existing curb width and preparing the surface with treatments including crack seal, 2" resurfacing, and full-depth asphalt repairs. It is a maintenance project and will not change the width or depth of the street. Best Management Practices (BMP's) will be utilized during construction to prevent debris from entering the storm drains.


