The project involves the replacement and relocation of emergency generators located at Vallejo City Hall and John F. Kennedy Library. The emergency generators will be mounted on mounted concrete pads within an enclosure. A utility trench will be dug up to install a new electrical and gas line and breaker panel to serve the new emergency generators. Traffic control measures will be in place during the duration of the project.
