Project Location: The project is located just south of the Town of Farmington, where Escalon □ Bellota Road crosses over Littlejohns Creek, San Joaquin County, San Joaquin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (37.92515°N, 121.00026°W).

Project Description: To authorize an existing electrical aerial crossing over Littlejohns Creek that was installed prior to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers implementing the Operation and Maintenance Manual for Littlejohn Creek Channels, A Unit of the Farmington Reservoir Project, in May 1963.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities categorical exemption (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15301), because the activity consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use. No expansion of existing or former use will occur. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
