Project Location: The Project is located at 740 KEVIN CT OAKLAND, CA 94621 (APN:41-3910-4), in ALAMEDA COUNTY.

County: ALAMEDA

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Professions Code, Section 26012, approved a Specialty Indoor commercial cannabis license submitted on 11/15/2024, by DSF Management Inc.

Project Activities: The Project will consist of cannabis cultivation facility within an existing warehouse structure. The project will cultivate a maximum of 7,280sqft of mature cannabis and 768sqft immature canopy. The facility will process cannabis on-site. Water is provided to the facility by retail water provider East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) and electricity is provided by Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E).

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is a Class 1 and 32 Categorical Exemption project. Class 1 Categorical Exemptions consist of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alterations to existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination. Class 32 consists of projects characterized as in-fill development meeting the conditions described in this section. The project is consistent with the applicable general plan designation and all applicable general plan policies as well as with applicable zoning designation and regulations. The proposed development occurs within city limits on a project site of no more than five acres substantially surrounded by urban uses. The project site has no value as habitat for endangered, rare or threatened species. Approval of the project would not result in any significant effects relating to traffic, noise, air quality, or water quality. The site can be adequately served by all required utilities and public services.
