6. **DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT:**
Extend previously approved temporary art exhibitions at five locations throughout the City (Third Street Steps, Heisler Park Lawn, City Hall Left Lawn, Laguna Frontage Road Pocket Park, and Alta Laguna Park) and to add one additional exhibition location (lower portion of Promenade on Forest). The requested duration of the temporary use permit is from February 20, 2026, to February 19, 2029.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15304 (e) - Minor Alterations to Land, in that the project consists of temporary uses with no permanent physical changes to the environment and will have negligible or no lasting environmental effects. Here, the proposed project consists of temporary art installations across six sites. Further, none of the exceptions outlined in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 apply. Heisler Park and Alta Laguna Park do contain environmentally sensitive areas (coastal property and open space preserve). However, the project is limited to temporary art installation and would not have negative effect on biologically sensitive resources. There will be no cumulative impact resulting from successive projects of the same type in the same place, over time. There are no unusual circumstances resulting in a significant impact on the environment. There will be no damage to scenic resources, including trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings or similar resources, within a highway officially designated as a state scenic highway. The project is not located on a hazardous waste site or any other site included on a list compiled pursuant to Government Code section 65962.5. The project will not result in significant adverse impacts to historical resources as defined by CEQA. As such, additional environmental analysis is not necessary to meet the requirements of the CEQA.

Therefore, the Planning Commission (PC) has determined that further environmental evaluation is not required because:

- The project is not subject to CEQA because it “does not involve the exercise of discretionary power,” or “will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment,” or, “is not a project as defined in Section 15378 of the CEQA guidelines.” (Sections 15060(c)(1), (2) & (3)); or,
- “The activity is covered by the commonsense exemption that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA” (Section 15061(b)(3)); or,
- The project is statutorily exempt, Section _____, <name> (Sections 15260-15277); or,
- The project is categorically exempt per State CEQA Guidelines, 15304 (e) - Minor Alterations to Land, in that the project consists of temporary uses with no permanent physical changes to the environment and will have negligible or no lasting environmental effects.
