DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: This project will rehabilitate the windows on the fourth floor of the Leland Stanford Mansion in Leland Stanford Mansion State Historic Park to help protect and preserve this historic building. The windows were restored circa 2003 but the materials used during the restoration have caused original materials and joints to deteriorate.

This project will:

- Remove both sashes;
- Strip paint to original;
- Make appropriate repairs;
- Replace glass with thinner, lighter, restoration glass;
- Glaze and paint sashes;
- Install new, more historically accurate sash cord; and
- Reinstall sashes.


