NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Project Title: Multi TD Silver Cliffs Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project
(Notification of Streambed Alteration, No., EPIMS-SBR-57459-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino County): Multi TD Silver Cliffs Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (Project) is located along an unnamed creek tributary to Troy Lake on privately-owned, Department of Defense, and Bureau of Land Management lands approximately five miles south of Interstate 40 and approximately 12 miles southeast of the unincorporated community of Newberry Springs, San Bernardino County, State of California; Latitude 34.73030, Longitude -116.50445.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No., EPIMS- SBR-57459-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The Project is limited to removing and replacing two deteriorated wood distribution poles (Poles 367229S and 367208S), and two existing anchors associated with Poles 367228S and 367203S.

Project activities described above are anticipated to impact 0.028-acre of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.


