**Project Description:** The project consists, in general, of the installation of two dual-port Level 2 electric vehicle charging stations, one single port DC Fast Charging station (collectively, EV chargers) and one 75 KVA transformer at the Development Services Center fleet parking lot, sawcutting and reconstructing existing curb, gutter and sidewalk sections, constructing new concrete sidewalk and footing in landscape area for installation of EV chargers, trenching, backfilling and placing conduit and wiring, installing circuit breakers, and placing hot mix asphalt concrete pavement, all within City property.
