NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Project Title: TD2181527 Tollhouse Rd Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project
(Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-FRE-60751-R4)

Project Location (Fresno County): The Project will occur at two locations in an unnamed tributary to Shaver Lake, approximately 0.7 miles northeast of the intersection of Warbler Lane and Highway 168, on the north end of the town of Shaver Lake, Fresno County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 120-110-18. Location 1 for Pole 1872617E Coordinates are 37.11243, -119.32054 and Location 2 Pole 4566750E Coordinates are 37.11255, -119.32050.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-FRE-60751-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison Company.

The Project includes activities at two locations, related to the replacement of utility poles. Poles 1872617E and 4566750E. Project activities at Location 1 for Pole 1872617E include the removal of one 40-foot long and 13-inch diameter wood utility pole and replacement with a 40-foot long and 13-inch diameter wood utility pole and the installation of a new plate anchor. At Location 2 for Pole 4566750E, a 45-foot long and 13.7-inch diameter composite utility pole will be removed and replaced with a 50-foot long and 14.8-inch diameter wood pole.


Exempt Status:
