NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Project Title: Post Mountain Stream Crossings (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-TRI-63029-R1)

Project Location (Trinity): The project is located at 660 and 720 Trinity Pines Dr, within the Trinity Pines subdivision. Assessor's Parcel Numbers 019-380-001-000 and 019-380-002-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-TRI-63029-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Pa Kou Yang.

The project is for required remediation limited to the upgraded replacement and maintenance of two existing stream crossings to meet design requirements for expected 100 year flows.

Type – **Class 2; California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15302** - Replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Reasons why project is exempt: This project seeks to replace two existing stream crossing structures with similar structures that are appropriately designed, aligned, and sized to meet 100-year flow capacity. They will be located in the same place with the same purpose and capacity as the replaced structures. This project is necessary to minimize ongoing impacts from sediment delivery to the stream systems and avoid risk of catastrophic failure of the existing structures. As carried out in accordance with the Agreement, this project poses no significant adverse impacts to endangered, rare, or threatened species or their habitat, and no significant effects on the environment.
