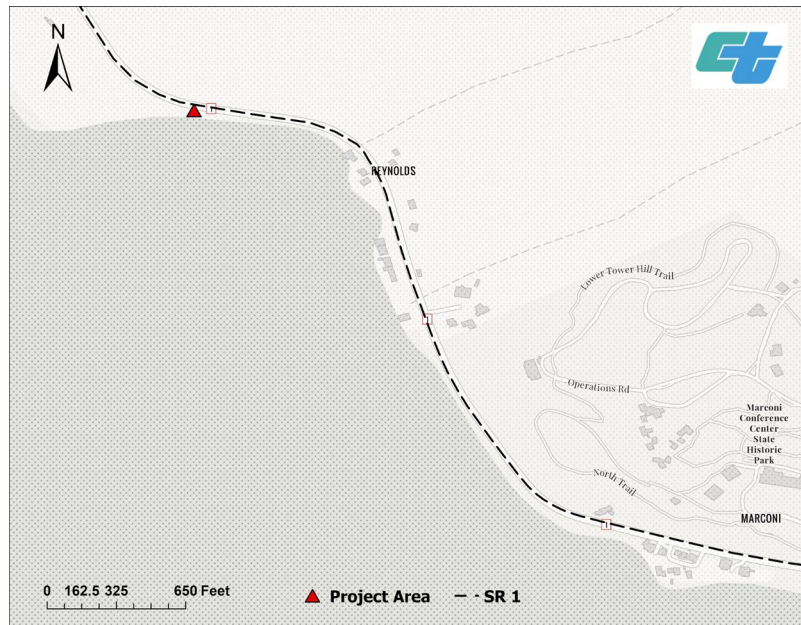


PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR STATE ROUTE 1 STORM DAMAGE MAJOR RESTORATION PROJECT



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has prepared a Draft Initial Study with proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the proposed Storm Damage Restoration Project (Project). Caltrans proposes to restore the integrity of the roadway and adjacent slope to prevent future coastal erosion and slope washouts on State Route (SR) 1 at post mile (PM) 37.2, approximately 1.2 miles south of Marshall Petaluma Road, near the unincorporated community of Marshall, in Marin County, California.

WHY THIS AD

Caltrans, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has prepared the draft environmental document (IS/MND), to analyze the potential effects the proposed Project may have on the environment. The document discusses potential environmental impacts, project features, avoidance and minimization measures, and mitigation measures. Per CEQA Section 15073, Caltrans will circulate the Draft IS/MND for public review for 30 days. During this time the public can submit comments on the Draft IS/MND. This notice is to inform you of the coming public comment period.
