Allow a new freestanding 130-foot-tall monopole style co-locatable wireless telecommunications facility, with a 10-foot-tall lightning rod and related ground equipment on a 50-foot by 50-foot leased area in the AE-40 (Exclusive Agricultural, 40-acre minimum parcel size) Zone District

The subject parcel is located on the northeast corner of S. Russell Ave. and W. North Ave., approximately 14-miles west from the Unincorporated Community of Mendota (APN: 017-060-31) (Sup. Dist. 1).

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Potential impacts related to Aesthetics, Cultural Resources and Tribal Cultural Resources have determined to be less than significant with mitigation.

Impact to Aesthetics are to be mitigated through the utilization of screened earth toned fencing and and hooded lighting to minimize their visual impact.

Impacts to Tribal Cultural and Cultural Resources are to be mitigated through establishment of proper procedure to address resources should they be unearthed during project related ground-disturbance.
