**Reasons why project is exempt:**

Section 15269(b)(c) Emergency Project: Emergency Projects are statutorily exempt from requirements of CEQA if the emergency repairs to publicly or privately owned service facilities necessary to maintain service essential to the public health, safety, or welfare, and the specific actions are necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency. The project involves roof repairs to replace skylight torn off from high winds in order to address the immediate threat to property and product.
