***SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108***

**Project Title:** Pilot Tom Timber Harvesting Plan 4-25-00172-ELD (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-ELD-65369-R2)

**Project Location:** The projects are located within the boundaries of a timber harvesting plan in El Dorado County, within CALWATER watersheds Upper Pilot Creek and Lawyer Trail and their connecting tributaries; Township 12N, Range 13E, and Sections 1, 3, 10, 11, & 15 and Township 13N, Range 13E, and Sections 35 & 36, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) maps Robbs Peak and Devils Peak; Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number EPIMS-ELD-65369-R2, pursuant to section 1611 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sierra Pacific Industries.

The projects are limited to the use and maintenance of water drafting sites, armoring existing crossings, and installation of a corrugated metal pipe (CMP). Further explanation of work can be referenced within the THP 4-25-00172-ELD.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the timber harvesting plan prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.

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- 6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The timber harvesting plan prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of execution of the above Streambed Alteration Agreement as Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
