Project Title: Wireless Right-of-Way Permit No. 25-014, Coastal Development Permit Exemption No. 26-022, and Categorical Exemption No. 25-086

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: An application to modify an existing T-Mobile wireless facility on a Southern California Edison wood utility pole located within the public right-of-way near the 30400 block of Morning View Drive. The project would remove one existing strand-mounted antenna, two radio units, one disconnect fuse, and one equipment shroud, and would install one new strand-mounted antenna (approximately 14.5 inches in diameter) mounted on the existing strand-mounted antenna kit, pole-mounted radio equipment enclosed within an equipment shroud, replacement coaxial cables, two RF caution signs, one disconnect fuse, and associated equipment. The existing 37-foot, 6-inch wooden utility pole (Pole ID No. 920685E) would remain in place with no change in height or dimensions. No excavation, trenching, or new ground-mounted equipment is proposed. In addition to City-issued permits, the applicant would be required to obtain permits for use of the pole from Southern California Edison and an encroachment permit from the City Public Works Department.
