Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The District proposes the improvements at the track and field, the proposed project would remove existing landscape/artificial turf, concrete pavement, the curb surrounding the track and field, asphalt pavement north of the track, additional landscaping and curbs, and various track and field equipment including the scoreboard, bleachers, goal post, discus cage, long jump areas, and shot put area. The proposed project would also remove the existing storage building, storm drain system and catch basin, and fencing and gates, and would relocate the batting cages on the site. The District would install field lighting, permanent bleachers, and a public address (PA) system. A total of 22 field lights would be installed. Additionally, To improve access and circulation, the project would construct a 20-foot-wide fire access lane connecting to the existing fire access route, providing emergency access along the northern portion of the varsity baseball field to the track and field. Construction of the proposed project would occur in a single phase, anticipated to begin in December 2026 and conclude in June 2027.
