Project Title: Cicada Ag, LLC (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 24600 East Lane (APN: 032-400-49-00) in the community of Covelo in unincorporated Mendocino County.

County: Mendocino

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Professions Code, Section 26012, approved a specialty outdoor commercial cannabis license submitted on January 11, 2026, by Cicada Ag, LLC.

Project Activities: The Project will consist of a specialty outdoor (LCA26-0000011) and a specialty mixed-light tier 1 (LCA26-0000017) cultivation operation located at 24600 East Lane (APN: 032-400-49-00) in the community of Covelo in unincorporated Mendocino County. An existing small outdoor cultivation project (CCL24-0000034) is currently operating on the property. The project will operate within the footprint of previous cannabis cultivation operations. The new project will consist of 5,000 square feet (sf) of full-sun outdoor cultivation and 5000 sf of mixed-light cultivation grown in 8 greenhouses, each 15' x 100'. No immature plants will be grown on site. Associated facilities found on the premises include an 8' x 40' shipping container for fertilizer and pesticide storage, three 10' x 10' areas for harvest storage, a cannabis compost/waste storage area, a soil storage area, portable toilets and 4 water storage tanks with a combined storage capacity of 20,000 gallons. Water is supplied by a permitted groundwater well. No processing or packaging takes place on site. Mature plants are harvested and moved to a third-party facility for processing. Electricity is provided by PG&E.
