Project Title: SCRSB LLC (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 100 SALISBURY CANYON RANCH RD CUYAMA, CA 93254 (APN: 149-140-104, 149-140-056, 149-190-031), in Santa Barbara County.

County: Santa Barbara County

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Professions Code, Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a 14 medium outdoor commercial cannabis licenses.

Project Activities: The Project will consist of the addition of 14 medium outdoor licenses totaling 63 acres (63 medium licenses) as of March 2026. The land use designation is AG-II which permits cultivation activities. No ancillary activities such as processing or distribution are proposed at the project site. One groundwater well is the sole water source. The project will maintain mitigation activities stipulated in the Santa Barbara programmatic environmental impact report.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is consistent with the local jurisdiction community plan and/or zoning designations. On February 6, 2018, Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors certified an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and approved the Cannabis Land Use Ordinance and Licensing Program. CEQA mandates that the project is consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. The project activity fits within the parameters included in CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 and the activity does not require additional CEQA analysis.
