The City of Chico proposes to transform the current intersection of Eaton Road and the SR 99 southbound on/off ramps into a modern, four-legged multilane roundabout. The Project is designed to enhance safety for all travel modes and accommodate future mobility requirements. The site is located at the intersection of Eaton Road and the SR 99 southbound ramps between Post Miles 36.1 and 36.6.
