This is to advise that the County of San Diego Director of Department of General Services has approved the above-described project on April 1, 2025, and found the project to be exempt from the CEQA under the following criteria:

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License Agreement Between the County of San Diego and San Diego Blood Bank

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Statement of reasons why project is exempt:

The License Agreement between the County of San Diego and San Diego Blood Bank is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301, Existing Facilities, as the use proposed is for a license at multiple existing County facilities involving negligible expansion of existing and former uses. The blood drive is temporary in nature, in that each site will only offer one day of temporary operation of the San Diego Blood Bank mobiles for the purpose of a blood drive during standard business hours. The operation of a blood drive for one day at each site does not constitute an expansion of existing use. It shall be noted that blood drives at County facilities have occurred in the past and may qualify as a former use. Additionally, the project will not impact environmental resources of hazardous or critical concern that are designated, precisely mapped and officially adopted by government agencies; does not contribute to cumulative environmental impact; will not have a significant impact on the environment due to unusual circumstances; does not damage scenic resources within a designated state scenic highway; is not on the list of Hazardous Waste and Substance Sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code; and does not cause adverse change in the significance of a historical resource.

This Notice of Exemption has been signed and filed by the County of San Diego.

This notice must be filed with the Recorder/County Clerk as soon as possible after project approval by the decision-making body. The Recorder/County Clerk must post this notice within 24 hours of receipt and for a period of not less than 30 days. At the termination of the posting period, the Recorder/County Clerk must return this notice to the Department address listed above along with evidence of the posting period. The originating Department must then retain the returned notice for a period of not less than twelve months. Reference: CEQA Guidelines Section 15062.
