The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) initiated a Director's Order to repair landslide damages on Interstate 80 from post mile (PM) 24.79 to 30.20 in Nevada County. Caltrans proposes mobilization, debris removal, clean catch basins, install drapery systems, ditch and drainage cleaning/repairs, repair/replace chain link fencing, install new barrier, traffic control, and incidental work.
