Project Location: Various properties within the cities of Chino and Ontario

Project Description: The 2026 Land Plan, designed to supersede the 2012 Land Plan, aims to fully meet mandated acre thresholds, and adhere to the principles of Proposition 70 (California Wildlife, Coastal and Park Land Conservation Act) and Senate Bill 1124. The vision for the region covered by this plan encompasses preserving additional open space, habitat, and public-use land, thereby realizing significant environmental benefits, and providing valuable agricultural preservation and open-space conservation opportunities for the community. Any future proposed actions on the specific properties covered by the plan are not covered by this exemption and shall be subject to further CEQA compliance evaluation.
