Title: Issuance of a Public Agency Permit and approval of a Right-of-Way Map – A5266

Location: Sovereign land located in the Pacific Ocean adjacent to State Route 1, near Big Sur, Monterey County

Description: Authorize issuance of a Public Agency Permit and approval of a Right-of-Way Map to support protection, operation, and maintenance of State Route 1, beginning April 7, 2026, for a term of continuous use, plus 1 year, for a Right-of-Way.

Name of Approving Public Agency: California State Lands Commission

Name of Proponent (Person or Agency): California Department of Transportation

Exempt Status: Statutory Exemption

- EMERGENCY PROJECTS (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15269, subd. (c))

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a Public Agency Permit and approval of a Right-of-Way Map to support protection, operation, and maintenance of State Route 1 is statutorily exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act. The actions are exempt as specific actions needed to prevent or mitigate an emergency.
