Title: Issuance of General Lease – Recreational Use – Lease 8498

Location: Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 4798 North Lake Boulevard, near Carnelian Bay, Placer County

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use beginning April 7, 2026, for a term of 10 years, for the extension and use of a pier and catwalk, and use of two existing mooring buoys.

Name of Approving Public Agency: California State Lands Commission

Name of Proponent (Person or Agency): Arnold Nakazato; Brian D. Walsh and Laura N. Walsh, Trustees, The Walsh Family Trust Dated: March 20, 2001

Exempt Status: Categorical Exemptions

- CLASS 1, EXISTING FACILITIES (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15301)
- CLASS 3, NEW CONSTRUCTION OF SMALL STRUCTURES (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15303)

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a 10-year General Lease – Recreational Use for the above-mentioned structures will cause only a minor physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemptions apply.
