Description of Project: The City of Redding proposes replacing existing electrical equipment and associated modifications at Building 21 of the Clear Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant. Work includes replacing the switchboard, motor control center, and automatic transfer switch. Modifications include disconnecting existing feeder, branch circuit, and control conductors; reconnecting to equipment; providing temporary power to critical infrastructure; and, installing a new utility bus duct, door, underground vault, conduit, conductors, wireways, and other miscellaneous electrical equipment.
