The proposed Special Use Permit for the "2026 Bike MS: Coastal Challenge" is deemed categorically exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §15304, as it involves temporary use of public facilities and public streets for a community event with no permanent alterations to the site or expansion of use. All event structures, including rest stop facilities, signage, and support equipment, are temporary and removed following the event. For these reasons, the project qualifies for a categorical exemption and is, therefore, exempt from further CEQA review.
