Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Project Location: Del Rey CSD is located on the east side of Fresno County, in the southern portion of the San Joaquin Valley. The District is situated approximately 19 miles southeast of the City of Fresno and 7 miles southwest of the City of Sanger. The cities of Reedley and Selma are approximately 14 miles southeast and 16 miles south, respectively. The District's service area encompasses approximately 0.465 square miles, and the Sphere of Influence (SOI) encompasses approximately 0.47 square miles. The sewer pipeline improvements will occur within the District boundaries. Existing WWTP facilities are located southwest of the corner of E. American Avenue and S. Indianola Avenue, east of Garfield Ditch.

Project Description: The CSD proposes to rehabilitate approximately 1,964 LF of gravity sewer mains using trenchless construction methods, replace approximately 886 LF of gravity sewer mains via conventional construction methods, and provide miscellaneous repairs and improvements to the District's WWTP.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The proposed project results less than significant impacts with mitigation incorporation to biological and cultural resources.

A brief description of mitigation measures included in the Mitigated Negative Declaration include:

Mitigation Measure Biology: Swainson's Hawk, burrowing owls and Nesting Birds: Includes preconstruction surveys, avoidance, timing of construction, and similar protection measures for protected nesting bird species.

Mitigation Measure Cultural Resources: Avoidance and/or care of undiscovered/unknown cultural resources.
