SUBJECT: Notice of Intent to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the San Jose Creek Multi-Use Bikeway Project

PROJECT NAME: San Jose Creek Multi Use Bikeway Project

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site encompasses a 3.5-mile segment along San Jose Creek between Temple Avenue and Murchison Avenue in the City of Pomona in Los Angeles County, California (refer to Attachment A).

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Pomona (City), as Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has completed a Draft Initial Study/Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) in accordance with CEQA for the San Jose Creek Multi-Use Bikeway Project (proposed project), as described below. The Draft IS/MND discloses potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project and recommends mitigation measures to reduce any identified impacts to less than significant levels.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The proposed project consists of the development of a 3.5-mile off-road bike and pedestrian path along a segment of San Jose Creek between Temple Avenue and Murchison Avenue in Pomona, California. The proposed project is identified as a Tier 1 priority project in the City's Active Transportation Plan; it is envisioned to provide pedestrians and bicyclists a safer off-street path of travel between community destinations and amenities in the city, which include the California Polytechnic University at Pomona, the Los Angeles County Fairplex, regional transit and bikeway connections, various parks and schools, and commercial shopping centers. The proposed project would consist of 15 access points, including 6 at-grade street crossings. The proposed project would also feature stormwater capture treatments, trailhead gateways and access points, wayfinding and safety signage, and at-grade safe street crossings along the 3.5-mile alignment.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

On the basis of the Initial Study, the City has determined that with the incorporation of the mitigation measures proposed in the Initial Study, the proposed project would not have a significant adverse effect on the environment. Mitigation measures for biological resources,

cultural resources, noise, and tribal cultural resources will be required to reduce impacts to a less than significant level. Accordingly, the City intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration, pursuant to Section 21080(c) of the Public Resources Code.

TRIBAL CONSULTATION:

The City is in consultation with Tribes pursuant to Assembly Bill 52. The results of Tribal consultation will be documented, including any mitigation agreed to, in the Final IS/MND.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS STATEMENT:

The project site is not included on a list compiled pursuant to Government Code section 65962.5.
