Project Title: I-880 Undercrossings – Washington & Broadway

Project Applicant: City of Oakland, Alameda County

Project Location: Washington Street and Broadway between 4th Street and 7th Street

Project Description: The I-880 Undercrossings – Washington & Broadway project will improve two I-880 undercrossings at Washington Street and Broadway with new lighting, wayfinding, and placemaking elements. At the Washinton Street undercrossing, the project will also include painted curb extensions at both 5th Street and 6th Street, and an upgraded curb ramp at the northeast corner of 5th Street. The project will improve safety, accessibility, and comfort for people walking, biking and rolling through the undercrossings.

The I-880 Undercrossings – Washington & Broadway project is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 21080.25(b) (Pedestrian, Bicycle and Transit), 15301(c) (Existing Facilities, Highways and Streets), 15302(c) (Replacement or Reconstruction), and 15304(h) (minor alterations to land). Each of the above exemptions provides a separate and independent basis for CEQA compliance.
