The Kern County Planning and Natural Resources Department as Lead Agency (per CEQA Guidelines Section 15062) has determined that preparation of an EIR (per CEQA Guidelines 15161) is necessary for the proposed project identified below. AGENCY/PUBLIC COMMENT: The Planning and Natural Resources Department solicits the comments of agencies, interested parties, and surrounding property owners as to the scope and content of the environmental information for the proposed project and the upcoming EIR. Any comments should be submitted to the planner whose contact information is identified above prior to the close of the NOP public review period. As mandated by State law, the NOP public review period for the proposed project is 30 days.

SCOPING MEETING: A scoping meeting is scheduled for **Wednesday, May 13, 2026 at 1:30 p.m.** at the Kern County Planning and Natural Resources Department, which is located at the address listed above for an overview of the CEQA process as well as the proposed project, and to receive comments for the preparation of the EIR.

PROJECT LOCATION: The proposed project site is in western Kern County, northeast of Interstate 5 (I-5), south of Burbank Street, and west of Tracy Avenue, approximately two miles northeast of the community of Buttonwillow in unincorporated Kern County. It is located on the east side of I-5 along 7th Standard Road. Access to the proposed project site is from 7th Standard Road, Wildwood Road, Burbank Street, and Wasco Way.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed Winston Solar Project is a photovoltaic (PV) solar facility with associated infrastructure necessary to generate up to 200-megawatt (MW) of renewable electrical energy and up to 200 MW or 1,600
