Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

This project will identify the location of a leak on a recycled water main pipeline, anticipated to be in the vicinity of the railroad tracks at the east end of Curtis Avenue. The leak was initially discovered in May 2025, and extensive investigative work on the west side of the railroad tracks did not identify the leak.

The scope of work will not extend beyond existing project boundaries and consists of repair and minor alteration of the existing recycled water facility.
