Reasons why project is exempt:


Approval of the Earth Day Celebration Special Event Permit is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15304(e), Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land, because the approved activity consists of a temporary one-day event with temporary event-related operations and required post-event cleanup and restoration. No permanent improvements are authorized, and no healthy, mature, or scenic trees will be removed. The project therefore constitutes a temporary use of land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment.
