Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Ontario International Airport Building Our Legacy and Destiny (ONT BOLD) Program (Proposed Project) includes the construction of a new terminal facility, Terminal 3, modernization of existing Terminals 2 and 4, and optimization of the Airport's terminal roadway system, vehicle parking, rental car facilities, and aircraft apron to meet forecast aircraft fleet and passenger demand. Aging terminal utilities systems and mechanical equipment would be replaced and consolidated and select portions of airfield pavement would be reconstructed to current FAA standards. A new Central Utility Plant (CUP), electrical substation, and fuel farm would also be constructed as part of the Proposed Project.

The forthcoming Draft EIR will evaluate whether potentially significant environmental impacts would result from construction and implementation of the ONT BOLD Program to the following environmental resource categories: Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural (Historic) Resources, Energy, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Noise, Tribal Cultural Resources, Transportation/Traffic, Utilities and Service Systems, and Mandatory Findings of Significance. Mitigation measures, if required, will be identified by the forthcoming EIR.
