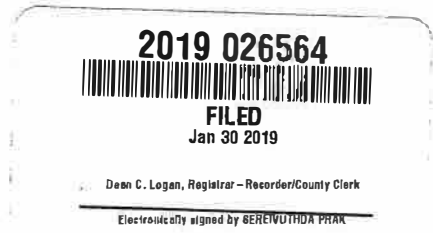

EXEMPTION DECLARATION PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

DATE: November 27, 2018

PROJECT LOCATION: Southbound Pacific Coast Highway at Torrance Boulevard

PROPOSED PROJECT: Construction of a Right Turn Lane

In accordance with Chapter 3, Title 10, Section 10-3.301(a) of the Redondo Beach Municipal Code, the above-referenced project is Categorical Exempt from the requirement for preparation of environmental review documents pursuant to:

Section 15301(c) which states, in part, that the minor alteration of existing highways and streets does not require further environmental review. This finding is supported by the fact that the project consists of a street improvement to install a right turn lane within an existing street right-of-way consistent with those actions outlined as exempt from environmental review under the Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act.
