Project Title: Trailer Parking Expansion (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SJN-65542-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to French Camp Slough, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.904004, Longitude -121.271062 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); 4199 Gibraltar Court. Stockton, CA 95206; Assessor's Parcel Number 177-280-610-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-65542 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Taylor Blanford/ Kimley-Horn.

The project is limited to the grading and filling of an unnamed tributary to French Camp Slough, which will result in permanent impacts to approximately 370 linear feet (less than 0.05 acres). Project activities will occur while the existing drainage is dry.
