Project Title: Amendment No. 1 to Revenue License Agreement No. 06-429 with City of San Bernardino Municipal Water District

Project Location: The Project is situated between University Parkway and Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad tracks, along the northern boundary of Macy Basin (APN: 0266-072-09) in the city of San Bernardino.

Project Description: The San Bernardino County Flood Control District is proposing Amendment No. 1 to License Agreement No. 06-429 with City of San Bernardino Municipal Water District for the continued operation and maintenance of an existing underground 24-inch water pipeline running parallel to the District Right-of-Way for a distance of approximately 930 lineal feet under Permit No. P-22003035. The amendment would extend the existing license term for an additional ten (10) years, from April 1, 2026, through March 31, 2036.
