Coastal Development Use Permit to allow:
1) Materials storage including culverts, bridges, road surfacing materials, storage containers, and dead storage of trailers for use in off-site forestry operations. Storage and servicing of heavy equipment and vehicles, including fleet storage.
2) After-the-fact approval for construction of a fire suppression training facility, placement of a mobile office building and storage container. Approval to remove asphalt grindings on the existing interior road system that were applied without permits

The initial application included log decking (storage of fallen timber for processing), which would have included multiple daily trips of logging trucks to the site. Neighbors to the site expressed concerns about impacts this would have on noise and traffic. The project was later redesigned to remove the log decking portion and include only incidental storage of materials and legalization of existing unpermitted uses (fleet storage and fire training facility). No concerns have been brought to the Department following the project redesign.
