Project Title: Amendment No. 2 to Revenue License Agreement No. 12-171 with Rache Canyon Mobile Home Estates

Project Location: The Project is located adjacent to Rache Canyon Creek, within a portion of APN 0164-231-24 and located southwest of the intersection of Rache Canyon Road and East Washington Street in the City of Colton.

Project Description: The San Bernardino County Flood Control District is proposing Amendment No. 2 to Revenue License Agreement No. 12-171 with Rache Canyon Mobile Home Estates for the continued non-exclusive use and access of approximately 45 square feet of unimproved land adjacent to Rache Canyon Creek, located southwest of the intersection of Rache Canyon Road and East Washington Street in the City of Colton. The License allows for the continued access and non-exclusive use of directional signage on 45 square feet of unimproved land within the Flood Control District's right-of-way. The amendment would extend the existing license term for an additional five (5) years, from June 1, 2026 through May 31, 2031.

Additionally, because this action is purely administrative and transactional in nature, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity may have a significant effect on the environment, and therefore it also qualifies for a commonsense exemption under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
