Project Summary: The Marin County Department of Public Works is proposing to replace the existing bridge over Olema Creek along Sir Francis Drake Boulevard with a new single-span, cast-in-place, post-tensioned concrete slab bridge approximately 77 feet in length and accommodating two 11-foot-wide lanes, 6-foot-wide shoulders in each direction, and new 2-foot wide bridge barriers in each direction, resulting in an approximate bridge width of 38 feet.
